Reading Curriculum



WITHIN THE ENGLISH CURRICULUM

- Phonics taught discretely within Foundation Stage and KS1 on a daily basis.
- Phonics linked reading books in KS1.
- Early Years library provides clear structure for children's phonics.
- KS2 daily Whole Class Reading – focussing on specific reading skills.
- Intervention sessions – Launchpad, Individual Provision Maps, MEP Targets, Precision Teaching
- High quality texts to engage children.
- Vocabulary taught explicitly.
- Daily story time from FS1 to Y6.

ACROSS THE WIDER CURRICULUM

- Subject specific vocabulary planned and taught across the whole curriculum.
- High quality texts in library and in topic boxes to support learning.
- Knowledge organisers used to identify key topic vocabulary.
- Well stocked library available to support both teaching and children's learning.

READING WITH PARENTS/CARERS

- Home/school reading logs.
- Home access to MyOn.
- Reading achievements shared in Friday Assembly.
- Secret Reader.
- Termly reading newsletter (to start summer 2021).
- Book lists for every year group shared.
- Parent workshops to support phonics, reading etc.
