Our Main Topic this Half Term is 'Magnificent Monarchs'

This term we are looking at 4 different mini projects related to our Magnificent Monarchs topic. The mini projects we will look at are 'Portraits and Poses' 'Push and Pull' 'Cut, Stitch, Join' and 'Animal Survival'. In 'Portraits and Poses' children will look in detail at different portraits, draw their own royal portrait and edit one of their photos to make it appear to be a real Tudor royal portrait. In 'Push and Pull' children will learn about how different machines and mechanisms work. They will also learn how to make a greeting card with moving parts. In 'Animal Survival' children will learn about animals in the wild and what they need to survive. In 'Cut, stitch, join' the children will have the opportunity to practice their sewing skills and learn about Cath Kidston.

English: This half term we will be learning to write a non-chronological report and a description.

The books we are reading:

- -Inside Royal Palaces We are reading this to help us learn about different royal residences.
- -We will also be exploring a wide range of books throughout our lessons.

How you could help your child prepare for the topic:

Please continue to discuss the Monarchs of our country with your children.

You can also research famous portraits of previous and current Monarchs of our country, as we will be looking at portraits in detail in one of our mini projects.
